



With passion in his eyes and a dream of changing people's lives with his music, 27-year-old country music artist Blaise Streets, who grew up in southern Indiana, started paving a path to a long career.

Young Blaise grew up singing gospel music with his mother and twin brother at their local church. He was also the lead performer in both the choir and musical theatre program in his grade school years. However, it wasn't until he heard Brad Paisley's "She's Everything to Me" on the radio during his freshman year at Indiana University Southeast that led him to attend his first live concert despite knowing very little about Paisley. It was at this concert that Blaise discovered his true calling to become a country music artist! Blaise credits his musical influence to one of music's finest legends "Elvis Presley", and country music star "Brad Paisley".

His self-titled EP was released on October 4th, 2015, featuring songs of heartbreak, love, and laughter with hints of inspiration from different genres while maintaining a signature country sound. Blaise signed with Nine North Records in Nashville in April of 2015. His single "Bring on the Sunshine" was released in May of 2015.

The 2015 CMA Music Fest was a major debut for Blaise with performances at various venues in downtown Nashville including "Manuel's Couture Store" and "The Stillery" on 2nd Avenue. He has opened for major recording artists such as Shenandoah, Parmalee, Wynonna Judd, Josh Thompson, and Gary Allan and has performed throughout Tennessee, Kentucky, Indiana and a few places and events in between such as French Lick Resort & Casino in French Lick, Indiana – Tootsie's in Nashville, Tennessee – The Kentucky State Fair in Louisville, Kentucky – and Charlestown Founders Day in Charlestown, Indiana. Blaise also auditioned for "The Voice" as well as "American Idol".

Blaise's has released several original songs since his career began and continues his unrelenting passion of creating and writing new music to this very day, as well as booking new events/shows at various venues weekly.

"I want to write songs that are going to change people's lives" Blaise says. His goal is to have everyone who attends one of his shows to have a favorite song of his! There are many paths for one to take on their personal journey, and Blaise intends to pave a *street* full of inspiration and good music for the world to enjoy!
